- Identify students needing additional opportunities to practice skills;
- Assess student skill level;
- Identify gaps in skills and learning;
- Provide opportunities to close the gaps; and,
- Assess students to measure growth.

The summer program will run Tuesday, June 20, 2023-Thursday, June 29, 2023, from 7:45am-2:45pm at SCVTS. Fridays will be closed. (7 total days) Compensation is \$285 per day for a total of \$1,995. Compensation will be paid from ARP-ESSER funding. Approval is based on student minimum enrollment requirements. Without minimum enrollment, offerings will be canceled.
